The Annawan Village Board met at 6:30 PM on July 8, 2025 in the Annawan Village Hall Board Room.

Police Report

The Board reviewed Chief Elliott's monthly activity report. There were 11 Calls for Service and 313 Officers Self- Initiated Field Activities.

Parks and Recreation Report

The Board reviewed Parks and Recreation Director Maddie Mackey's monthly report. The Annawan Canal Ambush is scheduled for September 20th, 2025. Registration will open soon. Food Truck Monday's have continued to be successful. Discussion was held over the Summer Rec worker wages. Discussion was held about giving priority to local high schoolers for the Summer Rec Employee positions, as well as considering volunteers to help.

Matt Nordstrom made a motion to pay the Summer Rec employees \$900 each for their summer help, with a second from Kate Sturtewagen. Motion passed.

Old Business:

Removal of Asbestos from Parish Hall

Bill Barnes got a bid to remove the asbestos from the Parish Hall. The estimate was around \$5,000. Discussion was held about having the asbestos removed and then rebidding the demolition.

Kate Sturtewagen made a motion to move forward with the bid for the asbestos removal, and rebid the demolition of the Parish Hall building, with a second from Kim Goodley. Motion passed.

Annual Appropriations Ordinance 423

The Board reviewed the Annual Appropriations Ordinance.

Kim Goodley made a motion to pass Ordinance 423, with a second from Kate Sturtewagen. Motion passed.

The Board reviewed 5 layout options for the new village website. Preference was shown for Option #1, with the addition of a calendar and Business of the Month spotlight.
